Mary Conger reminded everyone that the Buck Klemm nominations for NW Chapter closed April 19.

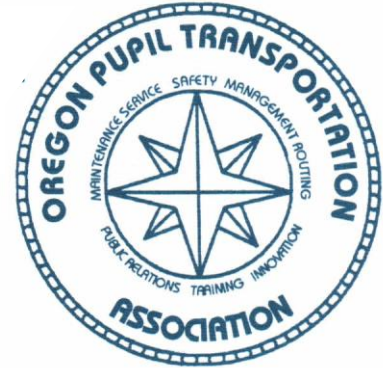
Mary Conger reminded everyone that the State OPTA nominations will close May 15, please go to www.optaschoolbus.org to get information and nomination forms.

Nominations are still open and will be accepted at the May meeting. Voting will also take place at the May meeting.

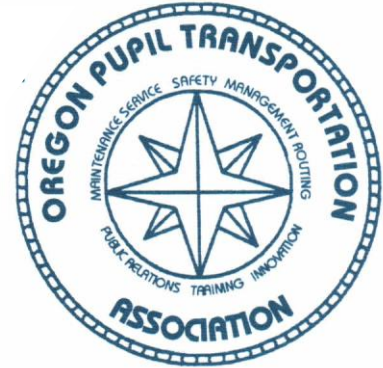
Roundtable Discussion:

There was a discussion on Drivers 70+ Renewing and Retesting.

Many have only one or two drivers in the 70+ and Sherwood has an 80+ driver. It has been seen that these drivers are inept with the pre-trip, not understanding how to drive off the brake on uphill and tend to drive more to the right rather than centered in lane. It was felt that the numbers will grow with the aging driving force and the need for insurance coverage.

Beaverton SD has 18- 70+ drivers this year. They follow the 3rd Party Testing criteria for these drivers. Failure the first time, 7 day waiting period with training in weak areas, Failure second time will result in driver being referred on to management for review. They have found that this gives consistency to all the drivers in this category. They also give the driver up to 3 hours of training in preparation to the first test.

Also will sponsor a Technician Training class with Cummins on 2010 Emissions

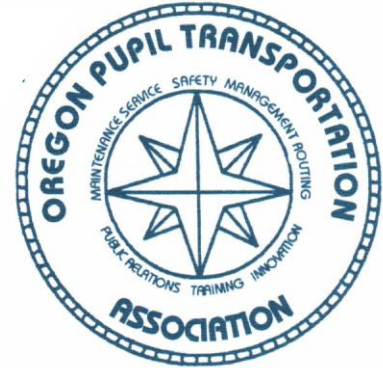
Western Bus will be offering an August class for Type C & D Technician training at their Boring facility. More information will be coming.
